Please bring your supplies or monetary gifts, designated for the Clean Water mission, to the **Church Office by March 22.**

The Mexico trip is February 16-26 with mission co-workers Pan Awsumb, team leader; Carl Awsumb and Beth Espy, installers; and Robyn Gibboney, health and hygiene instructor and translator. Team members from Mexico are Kathy Bianchi, translator, and Margurito Modesto, installer and translator.

The Ghana Clean Water mission trip is in April with mission co-workers Jim LeVernier, leader and health and hygiene instructor, Leslie Goodwin, health and hygiene instructor, Buddy Nix and Beth Espy, installers. Team members from Ghana are Michael ??? and Charles???

Requested Supplies:

- Pairs of scissors (adult, plastic handles, ones that are sharp)
- Rolls of crepe paper, assorted colors
- Reams of colored paper, assorted colors (lightest weigh)
- Permanent Markers, multi-colored with large tip
- Washable Markers, multi-colored with large tip
- Boxes of Crayons
- Rolls of Scotch tape
- Rolls of masking tape
- Glue Sticks
- New white twin, flat bed sheets to be used as banners
- Small staplers with extra supply of staples
- Boxes of Pencils, standard size, #2
- Glass beads, multi-colored pastel, flat on bottom, rounded on top; about size of dime
- Rolls of white (or light colored) shelf paper to use for drawing on
- Colored plastic tablecloths (a dollar apiece)
